The SE-CCI.NET system consist of on line information you need for business from several countries in the South-Eastern Europe region (Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Croatia, Macedonia, Slovenia and Serbia).

You can easily find and access to the valuable, up to date company information directly from the sources (Chambers of commerce and industry, partners in the project).

Within SE-CCI.NET there are several subsystem, (Country profile, Companies and crafts, Business opportunities, Legislation, Public mandate, Tenders and projects, Fairs, E-commerce, Useful addresses, Links, Publications and News), also on going projects in the every Chamber, with the goals to provide better services for connections between enterprises in the region.

Available subsystems

Through the SE-CCI.NET you can execute searches by name, activity, main export-import products etc. searches, in the Chambers registers to identify companies. Having identified a company, you can then obtain a standard information package, which contains the most important information on a business. For further information about identified company you can directly contact appropriate Chamber of commerce and industry.

How SE-CCLNET can help small and middle enterprises?

The SE-CCI.NET a network connecting national registers authorities in the participating countries (members of the Project). The information is exchanged between these registers, and as a rule will be made available via the unique WEB site used for national business information. How the information is presented in each country depends on the solutions provided by the national chamber authorities or their sub-contractors and legislation within that country.

The fees for information obtained through the SE-CCI.NET will vary, depending on where the information is obtained. Each participating Chambers determines the fees for the information provided, but much information on the system is free for clients.

Why do we need the SE-CCI.NET?

With the realization of the Single Market and a general increase in cross-border business, easy access to reliable information on foreign companies is gaining in importance. This extended market, however, lacks much of the transparency that both businesses and authorities have come to depend upon at the national level.

In general, small and medium-sized business enterprises have encountered more difficulties than larger enterprises in conducting international information enquiries, as they have less experience and resources (money, people, computers equipments, knowledge, etc). Using this system they can reduce they cost and investments in the developing their information systems.

The SE-CCI.NET offers the opportunity of linking national Chambers in a network with no barriers due to differences in technologies, languages, legislation, etc. By establishing a common set of information available online through the national Chambers, the SE-CCI.NET can offer information on businesses throughout South-Eastern Europe region through one Web portal. Information's are available on the national language and in the English language.

By making information about companies easily available and more affordable for all potential users, the SE-CCI.NET will contribute to making the South-Eastern European market a truly competitive market. By offering a system facilitating access to information on and knowledge about the regional market, the SE-CCI.NET enables the other countries to form a clear picture of the regional market. This in turn improves policy making in this area as the prevention of fraud and the infiltration of organized crime, as well as abuses of the freedom of movement.
